Action Item - Motion to Call the Meeting to Order – Meg Ricketts called the meeting to order at 4:01 PM.

Action Item - Approve Agenda for February 16, 2021

Meg Ricketts moved to approve the agenda. Melissa Linville seconded. All in favor.

Action Item - Approve January 19, 2021 Meeting Minutes

The minutes from January 19 were reviewed. Meg Ricketts moved to approve the minutes. Jeannine Hunt seconded. All in favor.

Discussion Item – Remote Learning/F2F Update

Dr. Cheatham discussed today's remote learning day. Some families were without their school issued devices. Students have 5 days to make up missed work as a policy.

Discussion Item – Principal Update

Dr. Cheatham shared updates regarding teachers and workdays. Each teacher has ½ day in February to help catch up. They also have 1 day in March/April/May to help prepare for next year. Substitutes will be used for classes. March 15 will be a ½ day learning opportunity on Number Talks.

On 2/12 the teachers did a data dig on iReady data. Each teacher has asked students to spend 40 minutes a week on reading and on math (some done at school, some at home if needed). This has been used as a tool for assessment as there is no data from Georgia Milestones last spring as they were cancelled. August data appeared skewed, likely due to students taking the test at home. December/January data showed several areas needing emphasis.

Staff is working to create more consistent grading practices across the board, as well as a more consistent timeline for entering grades, returning work etc. Study guides were also discussed and will be more consistent in the future.

Discussion Item – PTO Update

Victoria Tucker shared updates including that the positions for co-president and treasurer remain open. On 3/3 Brewable Coffee will be in the building for teachers. 3/22 will be Staff Appreciation Week. PTO will host a simple online donation fundraiser for the school in March. Professional of The Year and Teacher of The Year are upcoming.

Dr. Cheatham informed that currently there are 3 teachers who have submitted declarations for SGC, along with 2 parents. Declarations are ongoing at this time.
