**Action Item - Motion to Call the Meeting to Order** – Meg Ricketts called the meeting to order at 4:01 PM.

**Action Item - Approve February 23, 2021 Meeting Minutes**

The minutes from February 23rd were reviewed. Meg Ricketts moved to approve the minutes. Melissa Linville seconded. All in favor.

**Discussion Item – Remote Learning/F2F Update**

Dr. Cheatham discussed that there has been minimal change with remote learning. It was noted that the dates for virtual learning, following spring break, have been adjusted. April 12-14 will be virtual with Monday being asynchronous and Tuesday/Wednesday being live. The district will also be offering two summer school sessions: June 7-24 or July 1-22. Eligible students will be notified. Georgia Milestones will proceed as planned for grades 3-5.

**Discussion Item – Principal Update**

Dr. Cheatham shared information regarding Professional Learning Communities (PLC) and the drive to improve learning for all students. PLCs are made up of ALL members within the school. The goals of a PLC are to encourage learning at a high level, collaborate and drive results.

I-Ready testing results were reviewed and displayed lower than desired scores in reading comprehension and vocabulary. Math scores were mostly even across the domains, though rigor needs to be increased. When scores were compared to neighboring local schools the results were fairly even in the fall. Results from the spring show CCES having improved scores in both math and ELA. Georgia Milestone results will be compared with iReady for future planning. Dr. Cheatham would like to see reading and writing improve across all grades. Professional learning will be directed towards these goals, with increased training in Orton-Gillingham to bridge phonics. Overall goals to include:

- Raising the rigor of ELA/Math instruction by using assessment data to formulate learning targets for instruction.
- Improve reading and writing across the content areas in all grade levels.
- Increase strategies for differentiation in Math/small group instruction
- Increasing knowledge in and use of student growth percentiles and other data to support student growth analysis.

- Increase instructional focus on integration of Science and Social Studies across other content areas.

#### **Discussion Item – PTO Update**

Victoria Tucker shared updates including the donation fundraiser that will be held after spring break. This week is Staff Appreciation Week. Spirit Night for March is CANS and for April is Peach & the Porkchop.

#### **Discussion- SGC Elections**

Dr. Cheatham relayed that voting for new SGC members will be 3/24-3/31. Biographies for the candidates have been posted. Encourage participation in voting.

#### **Discussion – Budget**

Dr. Cheatham discussed the budget and that everything has been completed. She will possibly bring the MakerBus to campus for STEM activity ideas.
