# Board Policy Update -

The board reviewed the employee-student communication policy as recommended by the MSBA. School districts have until March 1, 2012 to adopt the policy. The board will approve the policy at the next board meeting.

# Separation Agreement Approval-

The board approved the separation agreement for a one year term. Any faculty members desiring to participate in this incentive program must complete the necessary paperwork by the end of business on Feb. 1, 2012.

# Eco-Recovery Presentation -

Joe Davis gave a presentation to the board on a shredding and recycling business that will employ individuals with developmental disabilities and give them permanent job placement.
