- On Thursday, March 22nd the District held a surplus auction and generated approximately \$8500.00 in revenue. Dr. Mulford recommended to the board to set the funds aside to renovate the West Plains Elementary library this summer. The library has not been renovated since the building was built in 1987. The board unanimously approved the recommendation.
