## MSBA Policy Update, 1<sup>st</sup> Read – GCA, GCBC, GDA, GDBC, GDM

MSBA provides school districts with policy updates to ensure compliance with legislation. The policies listed above relate to the requirements of employers in relation to the 2014 requirements of the Affordable Care Act. The requirements identified herein have already been or are in the process of being implemented to ensure compliance. These policies are scheduled to be approved at the next meeting.

### Technology Agreement - FantasTechs

Kevin Dulaney, the district network director, is resigning at the end of December 2013 due to relocation of his family. The district has explored a variety of options to fill the needs of the IT department. Fantas Techs is a St. Louis based company who specializes in IT needs for school districts, similar to what Opaa! does for food service. This company will evaluate, hire, and manage technology in conjunction with the school district to achieve desired outcomes. Board members approved unanimously on agreement that will allow the Fantas Tech to begin December 1st.

#### Food Service Bids

The district has been in the process of seeking bid proposals for the district's food service program. As a result, the district opened bidding on November 11, 2013. Dr. Smith recommended to the board to offer a one year contract to OPAA Food Service. This contract is renewable annually for four additional years until a rebid is required in 2019. Board members approved unanimously. OPAA has been the district food service provider over the past five years.
