Regular Agenda

Strategic Planning Update – 2nd Read

Dr. John Mulford, superintendent, presented a draft of the revised strategic plan to the school board in January. Over the past four months, a planning committee composed of nearly 60 community members met for the purpose of drafting a new strategic plan for the district. During a review of the plan, the board expressed concern that some of the wording was unclear and voted to table the adoption of the strategic plan until March so additional wording clarifications could be made.

Community Survey Update-

The district completed the second phase of the Thought Exchange community survey process on February 16th. We asked community members to read through a selection of thoughts and assign stars which best aligned with the participant's priorities. In the final process, thoughts and ideas will be reviewed by team of analysts. Themes and graphics will be created to assist in developing understanding of the results. MSBA Policy Update -

As part of a religious freedom bill passed during the last legislative session, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education is requiring all school districts to adopt a policy regarding students speaking at school events. The board adopted such a policy as recommended by the Missouri School Board's Association.

Opaa! Food Management, Contract Renewal-.

School districts using a food service provider must receive annual approval from the school board to continue in a contracted food service agreement. The school district accepted bids during the 2013-2014 school year and awarded a second 5-year agreement to Opaa! Food Management. The West Plains School District has partnered with Opaa! Food Management since the 2009-2010 school year. Board members unanimously voted to continue using Opaa! for the 2015-2016 school year.

Adopt 2015-2016 Calendar- 1st Read

The board conducted a first read of the 2015-2016 district calendar. The proposed calendar is similar to the current year calendar using corresponding dates.
