Pledge of Allegiance - The Pledge of Allegiance was led by students for the Jobs for America's Graduates (JAG) program. This program is new to West Plains High School and is funded through a federal grant. The primary focus of the JAG program is work with students to ensure a successful transition to the work force or post-secondary training after high school. The program targets students who are identified through a selection process aiming to detect students who would benefit the most from JAG.

MSBA Fall Conference, September 29th - October 2nd

Board of education members will attend the Missouri School Board Association conference this year on September 29th through October 2nd. The conference is in cooperation with the Missouri Association of School Administrators and will focus on engaging, learning, and connecting.

The new car will replace one of the older vehicles that is need of replacement. The district uses school vehicles in place of mileage reimbursement as a cost savings measure.
