Board Candidate Filings

Board candidate election filing opened on December 17 and ended at 5:00 p.m. January 21, 2020. Lee Freeman, Christena Coleman, and Courtney Beykirch are in their final year of a three-year term. All three board members filed for another term and were unopposed. As a result, no election will be required. Mr. Freeman, Mrs. Beykirch, and Mrs. Coleman will be sworn in to serve a 3-year team at the April board meeting.

Approval of Penmac for Outsourcing Procurement of Substitutes

Belcher Scholarship Applications

MSBA FutureBuilders established the Belcher scholarship program in memory of John T. Belcher, who was instrumental in developing innovative financing programs for Missouri school districts.
