

West Plains School District Board Update

February 18, 2020

Set Tuition for 2020-2021

Each year, the board establishes a tuition rate to be charged for non-resident students attending the school district (primarily the high school). As a reminder, tuition is charged for these students because the funding for non-resident students is sent to the school district in which they reside rather than the West Plains School District that they attend. Tuition billing is how the district recoups the costs associated with educating non-resident students. The district uses a formula to calculate tuition that is based on actual cost per student, as identified in the Annual Secretary of the Board Report. The tuition rate for the 2020-21 school year has been set at \$8,108.65 per student, an increase of 3.0% over the 2019-2020 school year.

Approval of Contract with FantasTechs

The board approved a contract with FantasTechs for the 2020-2021 school year. FantasTechs specializes in IT needs for school districts, similar to what Opaa! does for food service. This company evaluates, hires, and manages technology in conjunction with the school district to achieve desired outcomes.
