

West Plains School District Board Update April 19, 2022

Academic Update

The board was given an academic update on elementary and secondary curriculum in the district. The update included MAP testing, a Missouri writing project, NWEA Spring testing, and ACT prep workshops.

Capital Improvements Update

Dr. Davis gave an update on the district's current improvement projects, employment and food service.

The facilities updates include the WPE early childhood room remodel, repair of tennis courts lights and machines.

When the Coronavirus pandemic hit, the federal government funded a program that allowed all students to receive free meals, even those who were not previously eligible. However, recently the federal government declined to continue funding this program. The benefits will end after this school year. This means all families will need to carry a positive balance in their children's school meal accounts to ensure that their students have the nutrition they need throughout the day to learn.

Districts will return to policies that were in place for free/reduced lunch and breakfast prices before the pandemic. Eligibility for free/reduced-price meals will be determined, once again, by income verification or by direct certification lists provided to the school district. Income guidelines, application packets, etc., will be made available before the start of school in August 2022.

Oath of Office, Swear in Newly Elected Members

Cindy Tyree, Sam Riggs, and Reid Grigsby were sworn in to serve a three-year term. Mrs. Tyree has served on the board since 2004 and Mr. Riggs since 2007. Reid Grigsby was sworn in at the October 2021 board meeting to finish out the final year of Courtney Beykirch's three-year term. All seats ran unopposed.

Board Reorganization

Jim Thompson - Re-elected as Board President for one year. Cindy Tyree - Re-elected as Board Vice President for one year.

Erica Jones – Re-elected as Board Secretary for one year.

Dr. Wesley Davis-Elected as Board Treasurer for one year.

Approval of Committee Recommendation of Rebranding

The SCCC marketing committee recommended the name of South Central Career Center to Southern Missouri Technical College to the board. The name change has been tabled until May to allow for further discussion.

Salary Recommendation

The salary committee reviewed the district compensation and benefits package and presented the following requests to the board. The requests are based on the efforts of attracting and retaining quality employees.

- 1. <u>Vertical & horizontal movement: Vertical</u> and horizontal movement to certified & non-certified salary scales allow employees to continue advancing within our district.
- 2. <u>Apply a 1.5% increase across all salary scales</u>: Reward teachers for years of service and to encourage continued education while offsetting cost of living increase since the last raise

to base (last year was the first of two 1.5% raises in order to raise the base salary to \$32,000). By comparison, the cost of living increased by 7% in just the past year.

- 3. <u>Increase hourly wages by \$1.00</u>: In addition to the 1.5% standard of living increase, increase full time hourly wages by \$1.00 across the non-certified salary scales to be more competitive with the private sector. When years were added to the non-certified salary scales, it took the same amount of pay and spread it out over more years. This resulted in a very small pay increase from one year to the next.
- 4. <u>Adding a step to years of service</u>: retaining qualified and experienced certified and non-certified personnel within our district that has been frozen on the salary scale.

The board will review the proposal and vote prior to June 30, 2022.

MSBA Policy First Read

Each year, the school board reviews policy recommendations and adjusts as needed. Board members were given the annual MSBA Board policy update to review. These policies were reviewed and will be approved at the next board meeting.
