Consent Agenda

 Before approving previous board meeting minutes, the board approved the monthly financial report, resignations, employment, and transfers. They also approved yearly year-end reports, authorized officials to sign reports, and approved other bookkeeping procedures to follow budgetary laws.

Regular Agenda

- The payment of the monthly bills was approved. (The board approved 5-0)
- The payment of the BURO bill was approved. (The board approved 5-0)

Previous Business

- CSIP Update (CSIP 6.2)
- 2023-2024 Budget Review (CSIP S7 AP 1, AP 2, & AP 3) Dr. Wesley Davis. Below are some highlights:
 - The overall budget is expected to be approximately \$6,000,000 less than the current vear.
 - Less than \$500,000 remains of ESSER funding
 - The district will continue to operate summer school without an outside provider, resulting in a \$300,000 decrease in spending.
 - Two buses are budgeted for purchase.
 - The budget includes a step for all full-time employees, a continuation of the state's \$38,000 minimum salary grant, a continuation of the district's \$1,000 grant for teachers making over \$38,000, and the additional \$25 per month to be allocated for full-time employees monthly health insurance premium.
 - \$3,800,000 in tuition payments received from area schools
 - Continuing to seal the parking lots on the rotation, doors for WPHS gym, bleachers for WPMS, and approximately \$225,000 in Chromebook rotation purchases
- Approval of SCCC Name Change CSIP S1 AP1 Dr. Wesley Davis The board approved the SCCC name change to Southern Missouri Technical Institute effective July 1, 2023.

New Business

School Bus Inspection Update - The Missouri State Highway Patrol conducted an annual
inspection on the district school buses in March. The district has 27 buses in its fleet, and only
one had minor issues that were addressed. Mr. Orchard also mentioned that he will surplus three
buses that currently are not operational.

- MSBA Policy Updates-1st Read Presented by Dr. Davis.
- Approval of School Insurance Contribution Amount (CSIP S7 AP 1 & AP3) The board approved an insurance contribution of \$475 per employee per month for the 2023-2024 school year. Last year the board contributed \$450 per month per employee, increasing this year's contribution by \$25. This will increase the school's percentage from 88.41% to 92.23%. (The board approved 5-0)
- Set Date for July Board Workshop July 11 (The board approved 5-0)
- Net Watch Update (CSIP S1 AP 1) Casey Mustion from NetWatch updated the board on the access control project.
- Conference Realignment Update Dr. Davis discussed the possibility of combining the Ozark
 Conference and the Central Ozark Conference into a mega-conference. If this moves forward, it
 will most likely not occur until the 2024-25 school year. Games are being planned based on
 proximity and school enrollment. Current plans show West Plains will be associated with Rolla,
 Waynesville, Lebanon, and Camdenton for all sports.
