Common Application Details

Remember before you start your college application you will need to gather your General Application Materials for the Common Application.

- 1) Have a copy of your unofficial high school transcript or report cards. You will need to self-report your classes and grades in the system. You can find this info in your StudentVue in synergy.**
- 2) Have a list of your extracurricular activities from both inside and outside of school. You will self-report your information.**

- 3) Test scores and test dates from your college entrance exams (SAT's, ACT). You may self-report scores in common app. Official test scores must also be sent by the testing agency directly! It is your responsibility to send official SAT, and ACT score reports to each university/college. Interlake does not send scores. *NAVIANCE does not send scores.* Pay attention to what each school requires. Log in to www.collegeboard.org and www.act.org to send these scores. Most colleges in the US are now test optional or test blind.
- 4) Parent/legal guardian info (add educational background, employer info)
- 5) Common Application writing requirements: Personal essay: select one of [seven available prompts](#), 650 words maximum.
- 6) College Specific Application Questions: Questions may pertain to academic interests, scholarships or other general interests. Some schools will require supplemental essays. Know the requirements for your schools.
