- Discussed Goal Setting Activity and how it relates to Charter Dollars. We chose at the end of last year to spend the charter dollars on the second CST. Reviewed provided documents from SGC on what we can use the dollars for next year.
- Ideas:
 - STEM Specials- instead of having PTO pay for a science lab, they would go to the STEM teacher every other week in a special's rotation. That person would work with the teachers knowing what curriculum and standards are happening and tie it into the lab experience. It would then free the counselors back up.
 - Technology Support Teacher- AA that assists teachers with technology (Seesaw, etc.) and model and coach teachers. Could be a STEM expert as well, kind of like a technology liaison.
