

The college process (macro view)

- Fall
 - Apply to college (November February)
 - ► Finalize list, request letters of recommendation, update Naviance, apply, double check application for errors. Apply for financial aid. FAFSA, WAFSA, CSS Profile.
 - Community College Applications will open in March.
 - Apply to scholarships (typically between Oct. May)
- Spring
 - Receive college admissions decisions
 - National Decision Day
 - Pay your college deposit by May 1st

Waive your rights and sign the FERPA to allow your transcripts and letters of recommendation to be sent! No transcripts can be sent without the FERPA!



Email your signed FERPA Waiver to the counseling secretary or drop off in the main office!

Ways to help your child with organization

- Listen!
- Encourage student to use an organizational system. Spreadsheets work great! Start early!
- Put big deadlines on a shared calendar
 - College Apps
 - FAFSA
 - Scholarship Deadlines
- Talk realistically about cost and budget
- Build boundaries around when & what kinds of college discussions happen
