



**What is Title I?**

Title I is the United States’ oldest and largest federally funded program. Because of your efforts to complete verification forms, our school will receive supplemental funds to support student achievement. Title 1 provides over \$14 billion to schools systems. Addams Title I funds are also used to provide extra support to students, improve instruction, and increase parent participation.

**Attendance**

Our goal is that 96% of students attend daily. Currently we are at 94.4% attendance. Students should be at school daily to be successful. Students with perfect attendance are rewarded with family attendance lunches, weekly prize raffles and classroom attendance parties.
