District Updates

- **Guiding Coalition March 6th Meeting Highlights**
 - Need for outside lights at EHS at the parking entrance on 12th street and in the back along the bus lane.
 - Science lab updates at EMS were discussed
 - Attendance still is a concern in most buildings within the district
 - Elementaries are planning an after school math club following spring break to help with students at or near proficiency levels prior to testing in late April early May.
 - Transportation department is interested in the new BusRight software and discussed the transition with the retirement of the Transportation supervisor and Dispatch

District Maintenance Updates

- Emmett Project Graduation: Bleachers are being assembled with a deadline of March 14. This is the first home track meet. With weather conditions the past few weeks that deadline may need to be updated. The crew that is completing the work is hoping to meet the original deadline.
- Maintenance and Mr. Hyde are working on field maintenance of both the EMS facility and EHS football field. We have an action item on today's agenda
- Butte View South Wing roof is completed
- Football practice field sod was removed to create a practice area for JV baseball. This will not be a full field but a practice area for subvarsity teams.

Ten Year Maintenance Plan

- House Bill 521 requires a 10 year maintenance plan be submitted to access the funds. If 521 passes and the Governor signs the bill into law we will organize a number of public input meetings to help prioritize all the needs of the district.
- Weightroom remodel update, the bid to complete the removal and demolition of walls within the EHS weightroom is completed and we will move forward with this project at the end of the school year. This project was approved earlier this year for completion
