



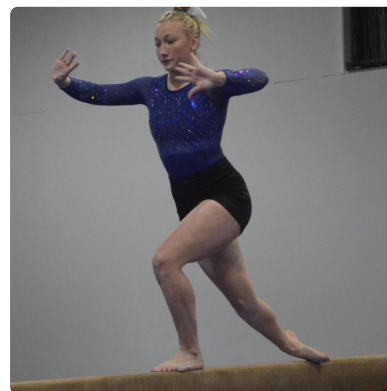

Hockinson Foundation Scholarship Applications Open Now

Hello Seniors and Families,

The Hockinson Foundation scholarship applications are open now!

- Open scholarship Enrollment - February 15th 2024:

- Website and applications: <https://www.hpsf.org>
- The scholarship and award enrollment window will close on **April 15th**.
- Available Scholarships:
 - **Hockinson Excellence Award**
 - Four (4) - \$10,000 scholarships - payable in four yearly increments of \$2,500 with qualifying criteria being met and submitted to the foundation at the year of request.
 - **Foundation Scholarship**
 - Up to two (2) - \$500 to \$1000 (varies) non-renewable one time awards chosen by the foundation committee based on applicants and money available.
 - **Finnish Lodge Scholarship**
 - One non-renewable \$1,000 award available to any Hockinson High School senior who will be attending a university, college, or technical/trade school following graduation. Chosen by the United Finnish Kaleva Brotherhood & Sisterhood of Brush Prairie
 - **Emma Koenig Award**
 - No application available
 - The Koenig family identifies commendable students of each graduating class from Hockinson High School to receive a one-time scholarship to a deserving senior in each year. The Award is paid directly to the college, university, or trade school upon confirmation of enrollment and attendance. Annually the amount is determined and presented by Emma's Mother on behalf of the Koenig family and in remembrance of Emma.
 - **Perseverance Award**
 - No application available
 - Funded by Nate's Plumbing, two to four deserving HHS Seniors receive the award selected by the HHS office staff. This one-time award honors those who have demonstrated growth through their high school journey and overcome challenges in stewardship as a solid community and civic leader. The 'spirit' of the award is to help fund education/training for students who have "persevered."

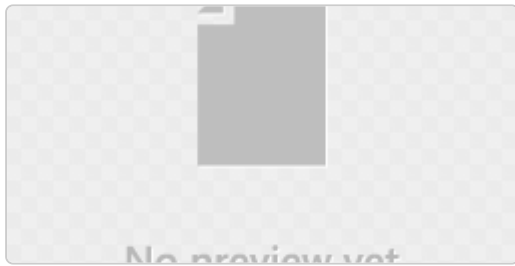
Mock Trial

WHAT IS IT?

Coin Wars is a fundraiser where grades compete for the most points (we are adding a fun Super Mario Bros. spin). Students bring in coins to place in their grade's jar for positive points and cash to decrease the amount of points in other jars. Of course, in the end, everyone wins as our school's library benefits from all funds raised!

HOW IT WORKS/RULES:

- Students are divided into grade level teams and each team is assigned a collection jar.
- Jars will be located in the library at HHES and in the commons at HMS and HHS.
- Grade levels will be competing against each other at their school as well as competing against the other schools (HHES, HMS & HHS).
- HHES students can put money in their jars between **7:45-8:10 AM** in the library.
- HMS students can put money in their jars between **11-1:30PM** in the commons.
- HHS students can put money in their jars between **11-12:45PM** in the commons.
- Coins are positive points. Cash is negative points. **Strategy tip:** Place dollars in opposing team jars.
- The money in each class jar will be counted daily and the points tallied. Point standings will be announced during morning announcements each day and posted to the PWT Facebook page.
- The grade level at each school with the most points at the end of the week wins a **SPECIAL TREAT** from Admin!
 - DISCLAIMER:** Each grade level at HMS has to raise \$300 or more to receive the special treat.
- At HHES, the winning grade will receive an extra recess.
- At HMS, the winning grade will get to pie Mrs. Colpron & Mr. Slom.
- At HHS, the winning grade will get points towards color wars.
