Dear, Wausau School District Families:

This is just a reminder that our third and final Independent Learning Day is scheduled for this Friday, March 8!

This means your child will not be in school on this day and they will not need to participate in any live instruction and therefore, they will not need to log onto any Google Meets. However, your student(s) will be assigned school work that they will need to complete. This work can absolutely be done at their own pace, but must be completed by Monday, March 11. That's, of course, unless your child's teacher specifies otherwise.

It's also important that we let you know that your student(s)' teachers will be participating in professional development on Friday, so that means they will not be available to you and/or your student(s).

So, what about the work your student(s) will need to complete? If your student is in grades K-5, please watch for further instructions from their teacher(s) in the Announcement portion of Canvas, our learning management system. If your student is in grades 6-12, they will receive instructions directly from their teachers ahead of March 8.
