University of lowa's basketball phenomenon Caitlin Clark has once again captured headlines with her remarkable performance on the court. She is currently one of the best female athletes we have seen in decades, mainly due to her impeccable shooting skills. In the current season, she has made 88 shots from 25 feet or beyond. In the past five years, the next highest single season total by someone other than Clark is 51. Every day it seems Caitlin's record and popularity grows by the second. Most recently, Clark passed Stephen Curry, who had 162 3pointers at Davidson in 2007/2008, and Darius McGhee, who had 162 last season for Liberty.

The components of this crazy duo come from our very own snack bar, and the ingredients are as follows: one spicy noodle bowl and one grilled cheese sandwich!


