Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Mrs. Trigg.

Discussion Item: Goal Setting Activity

The committee discussed how the committee can move forward and support the county's initiatives. Ms. Pannek discussed the idea of focusing on Tier 1 instruction. Ms. Stone asked about a comparative analysis of RHS and other schools and the idea of raising money to support RHS in other areas. Ms. Stone thought that a survey to teachers asking what they need to support kids and provide learning opportunities for kids. Ms. Johnson asked about the possibility of a foundation from RHS. Dr. Shaw expressed his experience with foundations and how they are successful when they surround a purpose. It takes a while to establish and get running. The proposals submitted by teachers and approved by SGC dollars, focused on Tier 1 instruction. The committee will continue to focus on Tier 1 Instruction.

Discussion Item:

Student Government posted a survey on Instagram. Students expressed an interest in the following: 1) more therapists 2) questions about new mask policy 3) vending machines closed during lunch 4) soap in restroom 5) outdoor activities

Dr. Shaw explained Cris180 at RHS. They are full and there are no more therapists to hire.

Masks are optional. If the numbers rise, then masks will return.

Federal government says vending machines have to be closed during lunch. The open vending machines were creating a disruption to learning. Dr. Shaw addressed the continuation of pep rallies outside.

A few items to need to be added to ensure that the SGC website is up-to-date and accurate.

Informational Item: Principal Update

Vandalism has surged again on campus. Dr. Shaw talked about the boys' bathrooms and the level of destruction. Dr. Shaw is hoping for students with information come forward so that consequences can be issued to the students responsible. RHS is currently mask optional. There was an off-campus social event recently where children have now tested positive. Cafeteria times are short-staffed. The school is short on bus drivers. It's difficult to find substitutes. Mrs. Stone suggested that Dr. Shaw reach out to RUMC jobs' programs to communicate the need for staff. Football has made it to the playoffs. There is a band concert soon. Both boys and girls CC won the region. Volleyball season is over.

RHS goal for graduation is 93%. Currently, the rate is 91.7%. While it's not where we want to be, it is a good data point. Dr. Shaw shared the graduation rate by demographic domain.

Currently RHS, has the following interventions in place to support seniors and improve the graduation rate:

- High-Density Small-Group Tutoring
- Recuperation, which involves students participating in online courses to remove WFs from transcript
- Recovery at end of semester for kids who have 60-69

- Quality Tier 1 Instruction
- Senior Week where seniors who have not met graduation requirements will remain on campus for the last week of semester to complete their course requirements.
