## Public Comment Protocol

The Roswell High School Governance Council welcomes public comment at its meetings whenever a Public Comment time is provided for on the meeting Agenda. A Public Comment time will be provided for in at least half of the Council's meetings in each calendar year. Public comment is limited to up to three minutes per individual, with a maximum of five individuals allowed per meeting, for a maximum Public Comment period of 15 minutes.

School and community stakeholders are welcome to attend SGC meetings to remain abreast of the work of the Council, but they can only participate in the meeting during the scheduled periods for Public Comment. The Public Comment period is designed to gain input from the public and not for immediate responses by the Council to the public comment presented.

Individuals wishing to make public comments at said meetings may express their desire to do so in one of the following ways:

1. Contact the Chair of the School Governance Council via email before the meeting, or
2. Sign in on a form to be provided at the meeting.

Priority is given to those who emailed, in the order in which those emails were received. If fewer than five commenters email, Commenters who sign in on said form will be allowed to follow, in the order in which they sign in. No more than five commenters will be allowed per meeting.

Per SGC rules, the SGC members are not allowed to engage the public in conversation, debate, or discussion during the public comment portion of the meeting. However, the administration will make a note of the commenter and either:

1. Attempt to contact the person making the comment or,
2. Address the concern at the next public SGC meeting
