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Informational Item-Flexibility and Meeting Norms:

- The RHS SGC meeting norms as listed at the end of the meeting agenda were reviewed.

Student Update:

- Students are processing and getting ready for the new semester. No other news to share at this time.

Principal Update:

- Construction:
 - Black Box Theater, PE Building and Art Extension are being worked on.
 - There are renovations being made to the art, broadcast video, cosmetology, food kitchen, and football areas. The field house is also being renovated.
- Budget:
 - All seed fund money must be spent this year.
 - Position purchases:
 - Data Clerk (\$29,179.99)
 - Math Positions (\$36,780 x 2 and \$17,356 x 5) **Teachers may teach on their planning time.
 - These positions will be funded from the Cost Center not the Seed Fund. No additional funds are needed at this time.
 - School Year 21-22 Budget Timeline:
 - 12/18/20 – Projected Enrollment shared with principals.
 - 2/8/21 – Budget opens
 - 3/12/21 – Budget must be completed and approved by the SGC.
- Second Semester Plan:
 - We would like to add more water bottle filling stations.
 - 50% of students are back in person.
 - Students will return to campus on 1/13/21
 - Starting 1/27, Wednesdays will be used as time to provide extra help to students who need to complete assignments and clear incompletes. We will use the modified schedule until further notice.
 - Grading will remain the same for the second semester.
 - Incompletes for assignments will be included as a “1”, not an “I”.
 - Students who are caught cheating will get a “1” and will have the opportunity to retake or redo the test or assignment. The new grade will be averaged with the “1” and will go on the student’s record.
 - EOCs will count as a .01%. There is an opt-out option.
 - We need to be ready to transition to full virtual learning if needed.
 - Spring sports will happen as usual.
 - Dr. Shaw extended appreciation to all staff, community members, and healthcare workers.

SGC Goal Setting and Parent Website:

- Teachers are providing support when students need help resolving incompletes. We can use Seed Fund money to support the teachers. This includes initiatives headed by Ms. Ponder.
- And Incomplete Committee was developed. Members are Valerie Petit, Hanna Zey, Ms. Ponder, and Darlene Trigg.
