Principal Update:

- Dr. Shaw thanked all SGC members for their time this year.
- RHS test scores have shown a lot of increases in various areas
- AP scores come in around July 4th.
- Dr. Shaw reviewed the numerous awards that RHS students earned this year in academic areas, fine arts, and athletics.
- We finished 10th in the state for the Director's Cup, which is an academic award.
- Mr. Ben Sutter will be our new athletic director.
- 31 kids have signed to play their sport at the collegiate level
- Our staff has won various awards and we have various points of pride associated with our staff.
- Mental health is still a focus for next year.
- We will continue our partnership with Northstar Psychological next school year.
- We were provided with a .5 additional counselor for 2018-19. This will continue into next year.
- New safety plans and trainings will be ongoing.
- We still have concerns related to social media. We are still trying to work with our students about the repercussions of certain things you post online.
- Vaping continues to be a concern. There is an ongoing push for education about vaping and this will continue next year.
- The graduation rate committee will continue to meet next year.
- We will continue our work with PLCs and staff mental health. We are working to meet our coaching needs, booster club communication and information. There will be a continued emphasis on communication and increasing our CCRPI.
- The graduation rate has not come out yet.
- We will continue to work on our numbers related to "closing the gap."

- H Hall is currently being renovated.
- The student restrooms are being redone. Some of the staff restrooms are also being redone. These will have new floors.
- The theater is also being updated and the bleachers in the gym are also being redone.
- There is still a plan for more construction. However, some has been stalled due to budget.
- As of July 1, we will purchase the additional bilingual parent liaison.
- Dr. Shaw felt that graduation went well. We received positive feedback about graduation. We opened the stadium later that evening for kids to take pictures after graduation. This went well and we plan to keep doing this in the future.

Request for Flexibility Update:

- The SGC can request an RFF for the process of getting student members to join SGC. The way that students are added to the council is written in the SGC handbook, but we can submit an RFF to alter how we go about selecting student members. This year we asked club sponsors for nominations and held interviews, but we can't do this next year. We felt the interview process helped to attract students that are actively involved and really want to participate in SGC. We were very pleased with the student representatives for this year.
- We still have about 12,000 to roll over to our next year's budget.

Budget and Finance Committee Update:

- The science materials approved to be purchased using strategic flexible funds have been ordered.

Outreach and Communications Committee Update:

- 2019 SGC conference invitations – We will need at least three people to attend this conference in the fall- September 21st.
- Council members felt this conference was beneficial last year.

Leadership Transition for 2019-20:

- Amy Jewett would like for remaining members to nominate themselves for a leadership position by the end of this month.
