Public comment:

- Lee Hills – Naviance is approximately \$11, 000 for the year and not the \$8800 that was quoted in the last meeting. This is based on approximately 2000 students.

Student update:

- Alexis and Claire would like a few reps from different grades to get more feedback to bring to the SGC meetings. They would like to get information from various students and pick a time and a place to make this meeting happen. All were in favor of this.
- Could the pep rally schedule be sent out to the students through Remind 101 or something of that nature? Students who take online classes are often not aware of schedule changes.
- The new cameras are a concern for the students. Students are concerned about what the cameras are recording, and they were wondering if there was a way to address this issue through a Buzz segment.

Principal Update:

- The new cameras were recently installed and the only thing new is their capability. Anytime there is motion, they are recording. They do have facial recognition. They have the capability to track where a certain object goes. These are a much higher quality than what we had before. We have had cameras for years, but these are just much higher quality. These cameras are linked to the county administrative offices.

Strategic Flexible Funding Update:

- We now will not have to pay for power for the new sign. We cannot put advertising on the sign. We are close to having this approved and will soon be ready to move forward.
- We are still working on hiring the Hispanic Outreach Liaison. We must hire this person as a contractor and not an employee to use SGC funds. The process is different and we are making sure to do this appropriately.

Request for Flexibility Update:

- We will be filling out the appropriate RFF forms to send out for public comment. This is for the general studies course and personal fitness waiver.
- We need to revise the math RFF prior to submitting.
- We are still waiting on the approved calendar to determine RFF days. There will be some guidelines this year and we need to wait to see what these are.
