**New member: Cielo Castro – JRTOC student representative**

Review of the RFF Interest Form prepared by Sutter & Short: Building the foundation of successful math students. Alpharetta HS is putting forth the same RFF. Discussion of methodology for opting students into or out of the class.

Hasson proposed limited day RFF, a concept that would allow seniors who were on path to graduate, without any credit recovery, to depart campus early. Concept is based on model implemented at Pope and Walton in Cobb Co. Need to confirm whether this creates a problem with seat time for students. Concern expressed that we might lose funding for teachers (FTE)

based on hours attended. Need to investigate how colleges will interpret this shortened schedule.

Martin, Short, Sutter & Huff to further investigate the limited day proposal.

Discussion of RFF submitted by Centennial HS for an internship program for all students. This is similar to a proposal that this committee considered earlier but committee has decided to revisit this.

Discussion of 9/10<sup>th</sup> ELA course recovery proposed by Alpharetta to allow for catch up. Need to research further whether there is a need at RHS among our students.
