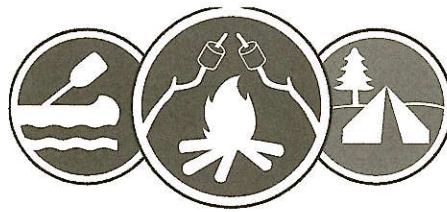



The three certificates, suitable for framing, will be further inscribed: "Highest Honors," "High Honors," or "Honors" as you indicate, in any combination you choose (i.e. one of each, all Highest Honors, etc.).

Award recipients must be young women who have completed three years of science and three years of mathematics with distinction, and must have been active citizens of the school and/or community. If you would like to honor your students, please submit your nominations online **a minimum of 4 weeks prior to your school's awards ceremony date.**
