Parking Issues

Hope Squad Parent Newsletter

Hope Squad is a school-based peer support team, made up of students who are nominated by their peers, that partners with local mental health agencies. Research shows that children and young adults who are contemplating suicide are more likely to reach out to their peers than the adults in their lives. In this way, Hope Squad members are the "eyes and ears" of the school building – monitoring for warning signs of suicide and helping to connect their peers with staff members who can offer the appropriate



resources in times of need. The Unified School District of De Pere has Hope Squad teams at Foxview, DPMS, and

Teens can obtain a permit in WI at age 15. Teens will not be allowed to apply for their probationary license until they are at **least 16 years old**, **hold their permit for at least 6 months ticket free, practice hours of at least 50 hours and 10 of those at night, and have completed all of driver education (classroom and BTW lessons).** Another change is that the **permit will be good for 18 months** instead of 12 months. The DMV has *not* announced when they will sunset the parental road test waiver; however the waiver program is ending and all 16-17 year olds **will have to take the road test**.

The new law changes the number of practice hours required during the permit phase, it changed from **30 hours to 50 hours.** The DMV does not collect the practice driving record when teens go for their road test however they may ask to see it or the **Road Ready app** which also tracks practice time.

Your teen should work toward at least *100 hours of practice with 30 of those at night* based on national recommendations put forth by AAA Foundation research in order to give novice drivers more experience before licensing (shows it reduces crashes after licensing). Our common goal for everyone is to have fewer crashes, injuries, and fatalities involving teens and all other drivers. Use of the Road Ready app is a great tool for them to track their progress of practice hours.

Who is eligible to enroll? Any student who is 14 years/10 months to 18 years old. Sign up information is located on the De Pere High School webpage under the "Students" tab under the Driver's Education link. Aurora BayCare Offers Student-Athlete Sports Physicals at DPHS

On **Monday, April 15** and **Thursday, May 9**, Aurora BayCare Sports Medicine will offer comprehensive sports physical exams at De Pere High School for students <u>currently in Grades 6-11</u>. <u>Flyer</u>

Appointments will be scheduled every 15 minutes, beginning at 5:30pm. Allow 30-40 minutes for the appointment.

The appointment will include a full health screening by a physician or physician assistant, a vision exam, and evaluation for ACL injury risk. This physical will meet school and WIAA requirements for the 2024-25 and 2025-26 school years. A parent or guardian must accompany the student, or sign a parent consent form.

Operational Referendum

On Tuesday, April 2, (just 21 short days away!) District residents will vote on USDD's proposed \$4.75 million/5-year non-recurring Operational Referendum. Do you have the information you need to cast an informed vote?

- <u>3 Town Hall meetings are scheduled before April 2</u> .Supt Thompson will deliver a brief presentation followed by Q & A. To date, 11 Town Hall meetings have been held in-person and virtually. Please try to join one of the remaining meetings if you have not already done so.
- Supt. Thompson and other administrators have also delivered the informational presentation to the Town of Rockland board, school PTO groups, booster clubs and local service clubs.
- An <u>informational brochure</u> was mailed to >11,000 residences in the District on March 4. The brochure contains key facts about what is proposed, why additional funding is needed and likely changes to the District's budget if the referendum is not approved.
- Today, the <u>Green Bay Press Gazette published an interview with Supt. Thompson</u> regarding the referendum. Not a subscriber? You can usually access several articles-- including this one-- for free during a month.
- <u>Operational Referendum FAQs</u> on our website have been updated to include responses to questions we have received. You can continue to use the <u>Ask A Question button</u> on the webpage to submit additional questions. You are always welcome to contact socialmedia@depere.k12.wi.us with questions as well.

Measles Information

Given recent measles activity in the U.S., and with the upcoming spring break travel activity, public health experts are urging people to check their vaccination status to ensure that they are up to date. Prevention is key! Please know, as of February 29, 2024, there have been no new measles cases in Wisconsin.

If you are unsure of your vaccination status, please visit <u>Wisconsin Immunization Registry</u>...[Immunization Record <u>Search]</u> (<u>dhfswir.org</u>) to review your vaccination record. Measles is a vaccine-preventable illness and very contagious.

Symptoms include:

- Fever of 101 F or higher
- Cold-like symptoms (coryza), cough, and pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- A generalized rash lasting three days or more
- Tiny red spots with bluish-white centers inside the mouth on the lining of the cheek (Koplik spots)

If you become symptomatic, especially after travel, put on a mask and immediately contact your healthcare provider. Please <u>click here</u> to view the flyer.
