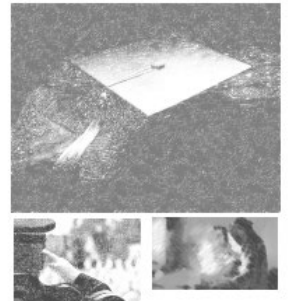

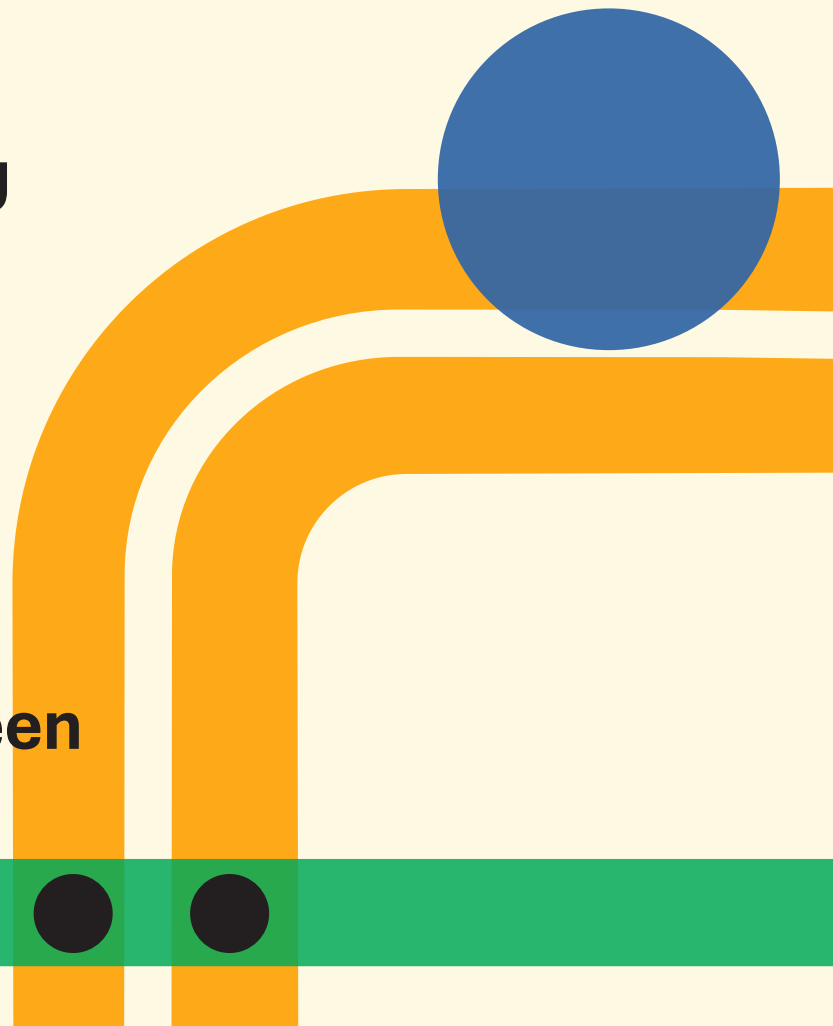
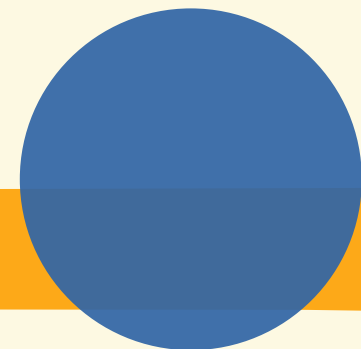

- **summer plans: rest, jobs, volunteer, travel**

- **familiarize yourself with applications/make accounts**
- **explore essay topics**

**Sept/
Oct**

- **finalize college or program list**
- **request counselor letter of rec**
- **work on essays in Eng 12**
- **attend college rep visits**

1. Skyward Message
