


Students currently in Grades 9 - 11 will select and add their elective course directly into the Student Portal in Infinite Campus.

English, Math, History, and Science will be added automatically to the student portal.



Grade 8 students will review the course selection process with their guidance counselors and guidance counselors will add course requests to Infinte Campus.


All students in Grades 8-II will work closely with their guidance counselors for scheduling support.












Start Today to Plan for Tomorrow

assigned by the computer


E = Elective Choices (your choices)
