**VII. Policy Review Discussion: Policies 0100 through 0118**

Mrs. Zoller led a review of the BOE Bylaws 0100 through 0118. Bylaw 0116 was found to be in conflict with 0157, with 0157 being most recently revised to comply with current law. Mr. Thomas asked about modifying the language in 0118.1 referencing societal influences. Board members concurred with both changes and it was agreed to keep a list of all changes to be brought back to the board at one time for approval.

**VIII. Board Committee Reports**

Finance Committee – Mrs. Johnson reported that the next meeting is scheduled for February 1<sup>st</sup> at 4:00 PM.

Citizens Advisory Committee – Mrs. Zoller and Mr. Feldmeier reported that the committee met on January 16<sup>th</sup> where Mr. Weber shared updates on primary facilities, the BOE organizational meeting, and District website revisions. Study groups continue to meet with reports forthcoming in February (Student Internships), March (Artificial Intelligence) and April (Food Service).

Belonging Committee – No report. The next meeting is January 30<sup>th</sup>.

Community Engagement – Mr. Weber highlighted the success of Primary Specials Night which was held on January 18<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Henke highlighted upcoming events on the school calendar for the months of January, February and March.

Facilities Committee – Mr. Weber reported that the Primary Facilities Steering Committee met on January 11<sup>th</sup> to plan for community forum #2. After reviewing the feedback from community forum #1 held on October 30<sup>th</sup> and reducing the planning options from eight to three, the committee further discussed removing option D1 (one K-4 school and two 1-4 schools) and moving forward with further dialog on options A1 (three K-4 schools) and C1 (two K-2 schools and one 3-4 school). Community forum #2 is being planned for mid to late February with a statistically valid survey forthcoming after the forum.

Planning and Goal Setting – Mrs. Zoller reported that a meeting was held last week to review 90-day priorities as they related to the 23-24 goals.

Policy Review Committee – No report.

Student Achievement – Mr. Weber reported that DLT is scheduled to meet on January 24<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Thomas seconded the motion.


