ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Collingwood offers the British Columbia Dogwood High School Diploma and Advanced Placement courses.

We offer a rigorous academic environment that also promotes health and wellness for our students. Therefore, we limit the number of AP classes our students can take in the following ways:

- Gr. 10: Students can take a maximum of 2 AP classes
- Gr. 11: All students take AP Seminar and students can take no more than 4 AP classes
- Gr. 12: Students can take no more than 4 AP classes

School policy requires all students registered in an AP course to write the corresponding AP examination set by the College Board.


OUR TIMETABLE

Collingwood runs a “2-5-1” trimester system. All students will complete their first 2 courses of the year by the end of October; finish 5 more courses (including all APs) by the end of May; and end the year with H Block. For Gr. 9-11, H Block offers land-based learning opportunities. For Gr. 12, H Block is Collingwood U: an experiential semester to help prepare for life after high school. Consequently, Gr. 12 students complete all their courses and finalize their transcripts by June.


