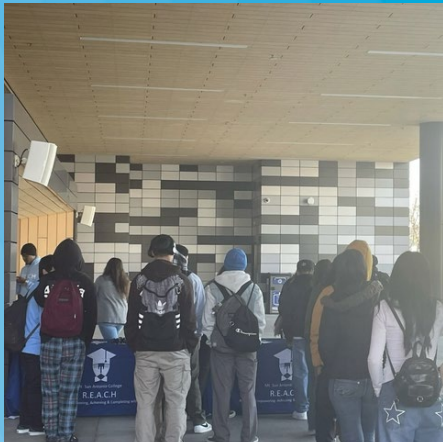




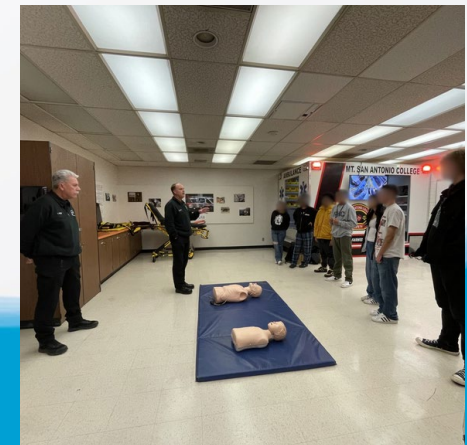
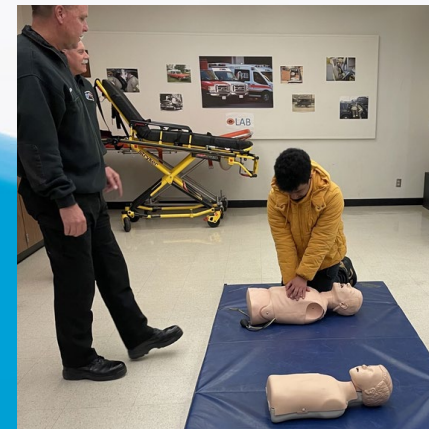
REACH FOR COLLEGE

Baldwin Academy Art Show 2024

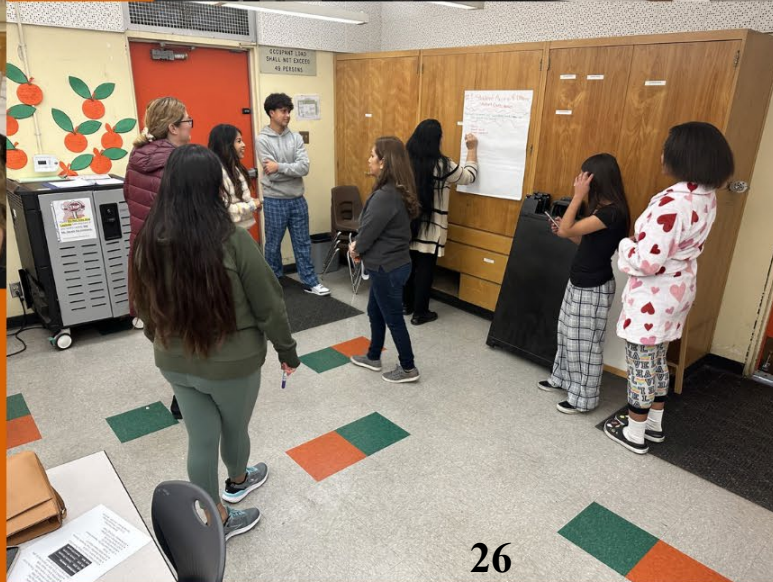
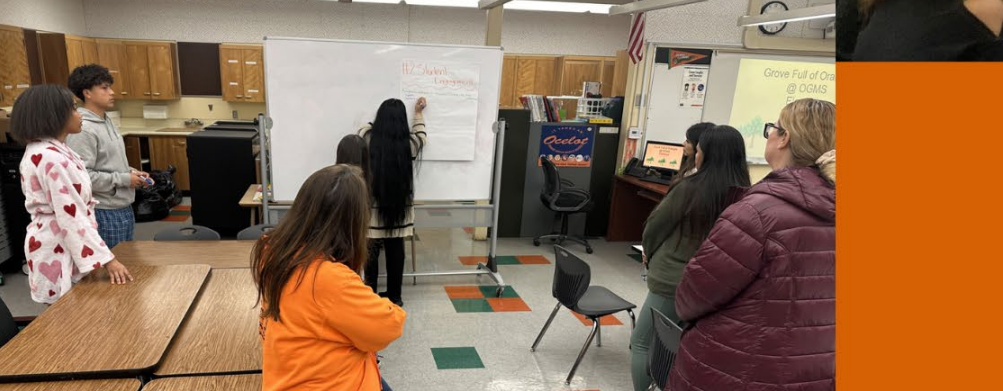
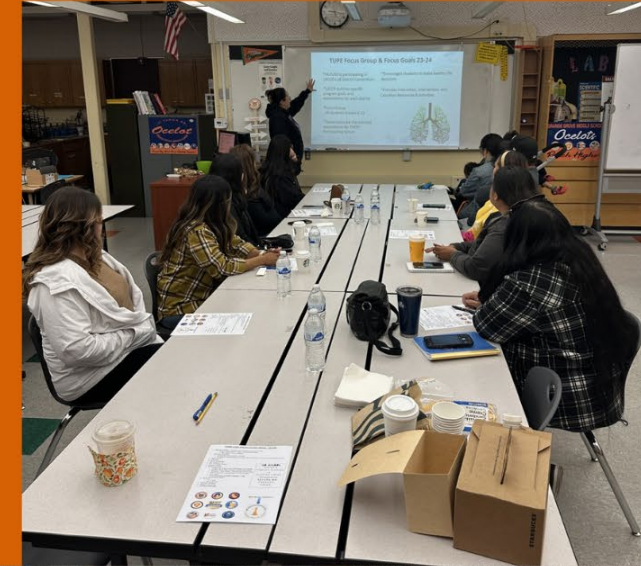
