STEAM: Out Teach is working with a cohort of teachers. They started with classroom observations and are currently providing feedback and working on lesson planning. Hoping to continue this relationship next year. PBL (Project Based Learning) training will need to take place. This is a part of the STEAM certification requirements. They are ask SGC for assistance with funding. Details will be provided.

GMAS Incentives: They would like to offer incentives to the top three students in grades 3rd-5th grade for their performance on the GMAS. They would like SGC to purchase Nintendo light \$200. They would like 3 (one for each grade level and a game gift card \$50). Roblox gift cards \$50. The last incentive is \$25 amazon gift cards. Total for incentives (\$975 minimum).

All present members voted in favor of the incentives.

Mr. Dow will look into any issues with purchasing the gift cards for the students.

Superintendent Advisory Committee:

- Meeting was this morning. The summer school was discussed. 10k students were serviced last year. Letters will be coming out soon for those who will participate this year.
- Internet safety session was mentioned it will be held from 6:30-8:00 April 26th at Innovation Academy in Alpharetta and April 28th at Global Impact in Fairburn. Teaching about online presences and keeping the students safe.
- They talked about devices being returned. Only students that are in summer school will be able to keep their device. There will be a place for people to return devices.
- Everyone should complete the parent survey. It is very important.
- The Milestones were discussed.
- The parents are concerned about the 2K incentive not going towards lower tier workers. They are working with recruitment and other avenues to increase retention including the salaries of teachers.

Teacher Appreciation: May 2^{nd} -May 6^{th} SGC funds can only be used to buy food for teachers. Options are May 3^{rd} Dessert Bar to include cupcakes and ice cream and on Thursday May 5^{th} a taco bar. The teacher's will be provided with something every day.
