**SELF-ASSESSMENT/PROTOCOL:** Mr. Dow asked that we review the self-assessment. We reviewed areas of strength and areas for growth. A question was raised regarding how the assessment was calculated to gain a better understanding regarding the data. From reviewing the data, it seems as if for the most part we are doing well as a council. The one area for growth is working towards ensuring that the committees are functioning properly.

**PRINCIPAL UPDATES:** Ms. Freeman gave the updates. PUSHING FORWARD is the theme for 2021-2022. CES is welcoming 8 new teachers. COVID guidelines were reviewed. State of the School was reviewed. Started SY with 60% scholars performing in reading k-5 scholars; we didn't not meet our goal in Math. Math will be a focus this year. There will be a lot of professional development for teachers, staff and push in for students. Our SEC students meet the goal for reading and got to 54% for Math. The new goals for SY 21-22 is 65% for

Reading and 60% in Math for Students. The 3 Big Rocks: Instruction, Relationship Routine, Invention. First 10 Days of School reviewed. Last Start Days reviewed, 3 Days per semester. SGC membership and we need PTA members. Mr. Banks is the interim PTA President. Textbook adoption was reviewed. Currently 35% of US scholars are reading proficiently. 95% of all students can learn to read. The simple view of reading: Word Recognition x language Comprehension = Reading Comprehension. You will hear about learning acceleration. This push in different than remediation. Ensuring that students has grade level assignments strong instruction, deep engagement and high expectations. Those are the updates. Questions where raised.
