 To what extent was there a measurable increase in student outcomes, teacher instructional practices, and/or school climate and culture as a result of the RFFsupported initiative? In the past four years, approximately 250 kids have been able to start an AP science class in 10<sup>th</sup> grade instead of 11<sup>th</sup> grade. This has created more varied pathways to graduation, utilized teacher skills and interests differently, and given these students a useful academic advantage for their futures.
