Discussion Items:

SGC Election Results: Jamie Bendall won reelection as a parent representative. Gillian Miller won election as a staff representative. Bradlea Satchfield has completed her term as an appointed staff member.

Council Assessment & Principal Feedback: Chairperson Halbert reminded the Council members to complete the Council Assessment & Principal Feedback surveys. She added that she emailed the surveys out again to the Council the evening before.

Principal's Report: Principal Jones advised we have open English, Math & Science positions, along with three open counselor positions. We are getting a Campus Security Associate from Cambridge. Principals will be allowed a 10% budget carryover. Starting next week, there will be weekly instructional plans published for all subjects. The Assistant Principals and Counselors will identify students who are not engaged and responsive during teleschool. They will then be calling the families to check in and see what assistance, if any, is needed. Principal Jones will be meeting with Balfour tomorrow regarding the virtual graduation.

Charter Funds Proposals: Chairperson Halbert took a vote on each of three charter funds proposals: Water Bottle Refill Stations, Cady Culture School Branding & Counseling Space Modification. All proposals were approved unanimously.

PTO Update: PTO VP Barbara Halbert advised the PTO has provided school social worker Patrick Hartigan with \$1000 in Kroger gift cards for Milton families in need. The PTO has also made \$500 donations to the Covid relief funds of both North Fulton Community Charities and the Fulton Education Foundation.
