Discussion Items:

Goal Setting Road Map for Strategic Plan:

Student Success and People and Culture are the two pillars that we are focusing on this year with regards to the Strategic Plan.

Student Achievement: going on current situation, it is difficult to establish reliable data for student achievement given the current situation. PSAT pushed back to January; EOC format/structure/weight undetermined; unknown second semester structure. Graduation coach is in place. English department frequently requires College Essays as a grade for seniors to ensure multiple sets of eyes; looking to begin discussion of Rec Letter application at the end of junior. Naviance is program in place (new this year) for college applications. Discussion of Second Semester Parent University for Naviance.

People and Culture: Parent University (hits both pillars); informal request for support from SGC for PBIS; PTO also has funds available for PBIS support.

SGC Spending 2020-2021 (Tara Spolan): All schools received an equal amount of funding this year; water bottle refill stations have been a success and are safe during the pandemic and it has been proposed to add more stations throughout the building.

Proposal approval pushed to January Meeting to allow for more time to acquire proposals. December Budget Committee Meeting will be scheduled.

Superintendent's Advisory Council Parent Update (Erin King): small group discussion groups in breakout rooms; work on polishing Parent Bill of Rights (process began last year); Freddy Benchine and Team is in the process of renewing Charter System contract.

Student Superintendent's Advisory Council Update (Pierce Rossman): small group discussion groups in breakout rooms to work on Student's Bill of Rights Draft

Principal's Report (Brian Jones): navigating world of Covid-19; graduation rate for on-time graduation for 2020 increased from 2019; large increase in English Language Proficiency for the ESOL students

PTO Update (Barbara Halbert): have supported staff needs with \$11,000, staff boxed lunch provided for staff with a giveaway; second senior snack was last week and had options for remote students to pick up their snack; helping to find lunch volunteers to monitor eating outside, helped partner to support a local family who lost a lot during the last storm.
