**Informational Items**

**Superintendent Parent Council Update**

- Jason attended last SPC meeting. Large part of conversation was about biases, challenges to curriculum and impact this may have on district's schools.
- New GA state laws require schools to give alternative curriculum at the request of parents for material they find objectionable.

**Prepare for SGC Elections**

- HFE is in good shape as far as required SGC candidates. School has 3 parent and 2 teachers running.

### **Principal's Update**

- Lori/Nan gave updates on security upgrade items:
  - Window films – Interior aesthetic films approved. District installed exterior film still pending and will not interfere with interior.
  - Lighting – approved
  - Additional security cameras – Not yet approved. Estimate came in higher than expected.
  - Playpad Sun Shades – Not approved. Project more expensive than expected at \$40k. New vendor has been identified to contact for bid.
  - Marquis – Fulton County requires uniformity across schools. Issue for HFE is finding power supply to Marquis.

- IB Evaluation had a great participation and favorable results. Zero matters identified to be addressed. Parent involvement was high. IB board found strong teacher growth and progress. Next assessment in 5 years.
