Information Item – PTO Update (Ann Nath)

- PTO Scholarships – still getting the word out – deadline is Monday 3/14

- Once a month raffles are happening, good turnout; will raffle prom tickets as well; reinvigorating the program

Information Item - Student Success Skills Update (Rebecca DeWeese)

- Will go through final exam week; Rebecca will begin performing walk throughs

Information Item – Superintendent’s Council Update (Tara Spolan)

- Annual perception survey – grades 4-12 and parents, 4/11-4/22; GDOE establishing new baselines for testing; if less than 95% participate in Milestones, schools will be penalized; new Curriculum Hub for parents; Dr. Looney is adjusting the calendar – less 4 day weekends and try to incorporate more early release days; surveying teachers to pinpoint reasons for so many leaving profession

Budget Committee Update and Charter Funds Discussion + Votes (Brian Jones)

- Earned 74.5 positions compared to 76 last year; projected to have 40+ fewer students as compared to last year; bulk of budget is salary/benefits; high school budget covers the cost of positions assigned to our cluster of schools; can carry 10% of budget from year to year – will carry over ~\$100,000 from current to next
- Charter funds - \$44,500
 - \$15,000 towards ID printer – will allow for purchase of supplies as well as printer
 - \$17,000 towards Media Center - for podcasting/film studio equipment – ipads, tripods, green screen kit, microphones, sd cards, acoustic soundproofing materials, additional lighting, as well as funding for book purchases
 - \$12,000 for a community garden – plans will have to be approved by the county
