

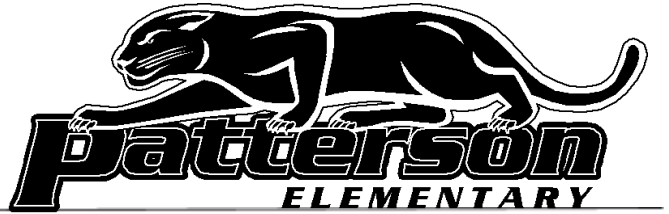

Recent Event Updates:

- Book Fair-\$1300 despite school closure (last yr \$1600)
- T-Shirts (Erin Mason)- **2nd order of 16 - went well**

PE Funds (Mr. Twigg): **Thank you to Booster Club for items already in use!!**

- Purchased in Dec-Needs: Wireless Microphone headset: \$200-300, 20 Pinnies= \$100, Dozen Potato Sacks= \$55, Cone Covers= \$24, Cone plastic covers= \$18, 1/2 Dozen Foam Balls = \$79, Omiken Ball replacement Bladder= \$55, 24 Foam soccer balls = \$600, 18 Foam flying discs = \$130, Lumber (to build extra storage platform in equipment room) = \$100-\$200, Dozen Fleece Balls = \$70, 8 rolls Floor Tape = \$40, Three 18" pop-up nets= \$390, Long Jump Mat= \$78, Spotify Subscription (wireless music capability): \$12/mo. X 10 months= \$120TOTAL= Roughly \$2,000

- **Reviews about Rock Wall from other PE Teachers - mostly negative! Definitely needs a cover, not an everyday item, installation cumbersome**

- **Pedometers - could use everyday; made specifically for PE classes; durable; info downloads directly to Mr Twigg's computer (can attach this info to report cards); a set of 36 pedometers with 2 download stations, a book, and a carrying case is \$1359**
- **Mr Twigg would prefer the Pedometers: Kids learn more about their own bodies, more useful, more data**
- **Other wishes:**
 - **Finger light balls: slow up, slow down. Good for kinders, hand-eye coordination and they last a long time. \$8-\$16 each, so a full class worth is about \$400**
 - **OGO Disks - also good for kinders. come in sets of 2 @ \$12 each, so about \$400 for a full class.**
