Recent Event Updates:

- Treasurer Report on Bonus Funds Teachers thankful, but has been a bit of a mess, with teachers over spending, Treasurer doesn't think a Bonus Method is a great idea for future years
- Mr Twigg PE needs Proposal PE increasing hours in 2017-18 year, Current School Budget for PE \$75, is hoping to up that to \$200, BLAST using equipment, Neill will try to contact BLAST about helping to replenish equipment, Asking for additional \$600 to original \$200 to equal \$1000 (when incl \$200 from school) on an annual basis to replenish current supplies worn out & to purchase future assets/equipment that we currently don't have and that he currently borrows from other schools. Items mentioned include: Headset for PE Teacher to not have to yell across gym @\$150, Pop-up Nets since PE starts right away in morning doesn't have class prep time since kids are in the gym until just before for morning line up @ \$130ea, wants 6, Needs new pump for Omnikin Ball, Needs replacement dodgeballs/softballs @ \$30ea, many already ductaped to stay together, Needs Foam Bowling Pins to decrease dangers from hitting kids with current hard plastic ones during activities, Needs new batting tees (was planning to build own to save cost using pvc & insulation method), Needs additional Co-op games to encourage more working together to coincide with PE curriculum, Wants Pedometers for kids, Wants Heart Rate station to show kids heart rate better, Needs Stop Watches, Borrowing a lot of equipment from other schools, would like to have own set so can be used however often needed. Willing to give excess balls, like soccer, play balls, bballs to Recess as exchange for funds. Willing to give additional Everybody Loves PE certificates to Auction Sales as help for funds. Discussed reducing money spent on Poster Pictures so current \$200 can be spent more on equipment. Discussed changing the Panther Dash from Art Run to PE Equipment Run. Decided to give \$600 Bonus for this year, to be used before school year over. Will return to Nov PBC Mtg to see how Panther Dash did for future funds. Will pass balls along to Recess. Voted 9 Yes, 0 No
- Restaurant Night-Burgerville May 24th, \$357.63, Vote on use
 Possible Options: Recess? (Last yr Thank you to Mrs. Shapland, worked whole time, but Recess received no extras)
 PE? \$100 Bonus to Recess to cover \$50 over and \$50 new bballs, will use PE balls too. Voted 10 yes, 0 no.
 Other Options? Save toward future budgets? Remaining Funds to go into budget to be used toward PE Bonus as well.
- Moms-n-Muffins-May 12 7-7:40a, estimated 450 ppl, great turn out, need more tables, muffins almost exact Next year suggestion was to ¼ some muffins in the beginning so people can choose to take ½ or ¼ based on how much they think they or their child will eat, to reduce waste and to allow current 18 dozen? to cover head count, as this year we had to ¼ right at the end for last 30 ppl, but ended up that many of those went back to finish off ¼ pieces to receive a total of ½. Did purchase 2 extra dozen in final moments, but they arrived late and weren't really needed, so only given to volunteers and sold back to Emily & JM.

- 2016-17 Elections-Review New Board Christina Webb Restaurant Night Coordinator asked about how many Restaurant Nights we can do? Said she could run with it, but needs to not be a Community Event (where teachers serve etc), but a Fundraiser (where people go as desired with flier to show PBC to receive funds), will be working on McMenamin's for next year. JM concerned with pushing too many Fundraisers, but will let Christina run with it as desired.
- 2016-17 Calendar-1 minor change Bingo Night from 28th to 21st due to annual conflicts with Scouting Events No complaints to this change, except Emily Mack not available so JM will head this event up.

Did not raise Recess for next year.
