## **Discussion Items:**.

- SGC Funds- Mr. Collins presented the budget proposal.
  - The SGC is allotted \$46,690.00 for the year.
  - College and Career Readiness Support (college fairs and tours, funds to offset use of charter buses for local and out-of-state tours. \$15,000.00)
  - PBIS \$1,000.00, Funds will go towards Popcorn Machine, Karaoke Machine, Giant Jenga, Scattegories (game), The LOGO game, Karaoke Machine Backdrop, Portable Stage.
  - Athletics department- 13, 000 Funds will purchase cryotherapy machines to be utilized for rehabilitation. Funds released on the contingency that athletics will fundraise \$3000.00 for the purchase of the 2<sup>nd</sup> machine.
  - Milestone and AP Bootcamp- 13,000.00 Instructional resources and support for Advanced Placement and End-of-Course test areas and grant scholars additional out-of-class time instruction to practice and prepare towards content mastery.
  - Teacher and Student Incentives- \$4, 390. Funds will be used to purchase items such as electronics to incentivize good attendance. Additionally, funds will go towards hosting celebratory events that recognize students who have consistently demonstrated good attendance, and those who have made attendance improvements throughout the school year.
  - The items proposed come to a total of \$46, 390.00.
  - Mr. Collins moved for the proposed budget to be approved as presented.
    Mr. Joshua Leonard 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. It was moved and approved by the committee members.
- **Principal Update-** Last year, LHHS received funds to help with safety and security. We decided to purchase Metal/Weapons Detectors. The proposal to purchase the detectors went through a vetting process. Over the next few weeks, we will try out the weapons detectors in the school. They will be placed in two entry ways and two exits. No incident occurred which lead us to try out the detectors, we just want to be cautious.
