Pledge of Allegiance

Contracts were approved for Certified Career Staff and Retired Certified Staff. Temporary contracts on a 1st or 2nd year basis were also approved.

Increase of Building Fund from State Aid and/ or Federal Funds for Schools

Each year Altus Public Schools creates an estimate of needs. The District cannot spend more money in a school year that is not appropriated in that estimate of needs. The Board voted to increase the Building Fund by \$2.5 million dollars that the District received from the Department of Defense for the Rivers project.
