Welcome

Ms. Monica Zavala called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. She welcomed the group and had everyone go around and introduce themselves.

Discussion Items

- Ms. Beavers began with an icebreaker activity.

The group had a series of questions and went around and shared their responses.

- Ms. Zavala shared a PowerPoint about the Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child (WSCC).

Monica shared that families and community agencies play an important role in the WSCC approach. It's also student-led so they feel more comfortable receiving outside sources.

Ms. LaToya Beavers also spoke about the purpose and importance of the WSCC approach to our students and faculty.

Mr. Robert Glynn shared that they use perpetual data. He shared an example of the current "trends" and how those affect students day to day. He also shared how referral data, failure data, and violence trends affect what they do. This is a way for the Student Services team to reach out to students who could be considered high-risk.

Ms. Zavala allowed questions from the group.

Dr. Johnson shared that the Stronger Connections Grant marries with the WSCC approach. She stated that if the environment is safe a child has a place they can learn and have a sense of belonging. We want to build a place for inclusivity.
