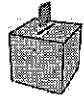

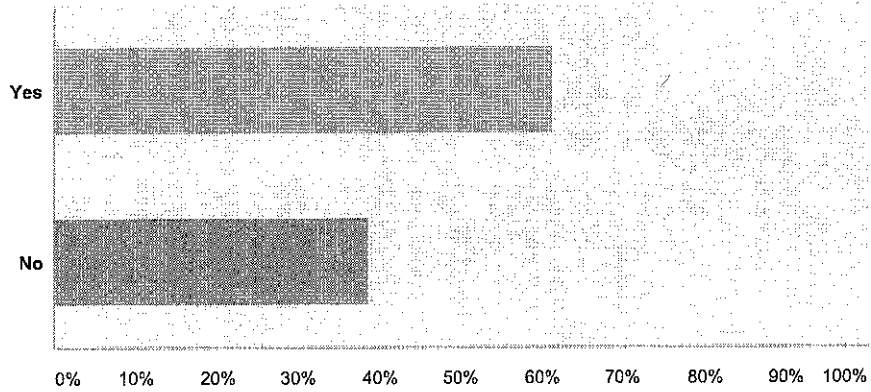

Q1 I would prefer to continue with three (3) release days that are aligned to the surrounding middle and high schools.

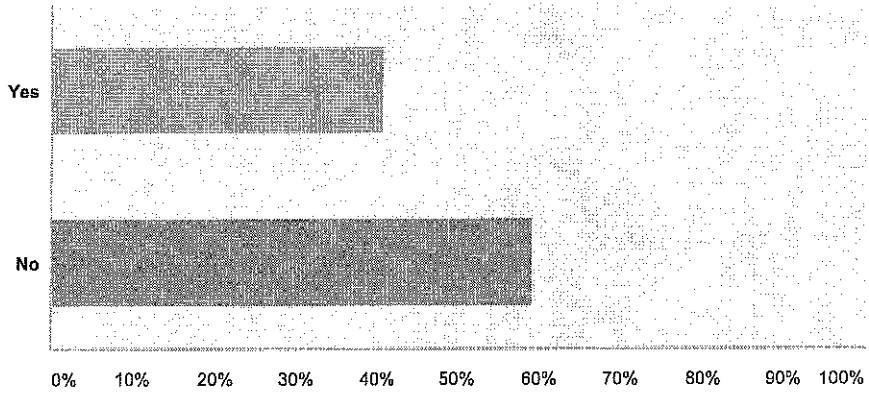

AM.**

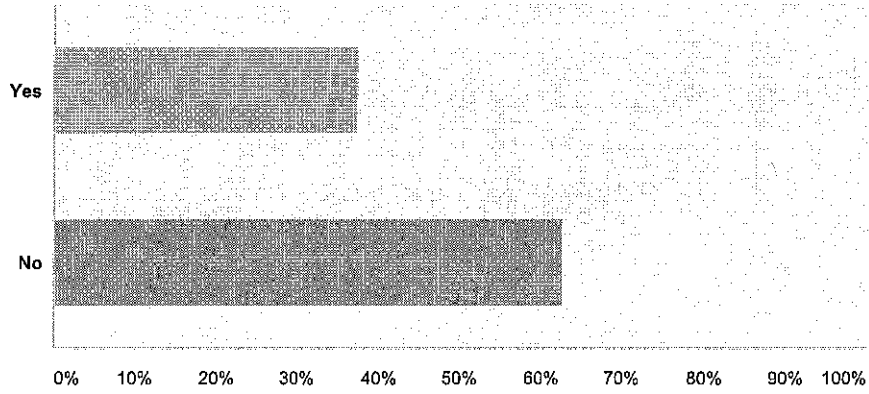
