Student Medication and Emergency Procedures

- Ms. Sandquist is a healthcare professional and will care for all non-emergent medical needs. All staff are CPR and First aid certified.
- Prescription Medication: **All prescription medication will be stored and administered by Ms. Sandquist - students may not keep medication with their personal belongings.**
- Prescription medications need to be **in the original prescription bottle** and placed inside a quart size ziplock bag **with the student's name clearly written on the bag** and will be collected by Ms. Sandquist upon arrival at the airport on 3/23.
- In the event of an emergency, we will transport the student to the nearest medical facility in Belmopan, the capital (15 minute drive).
- **Vaccinations:** Please refer to [cdc.gov](https://www.cdc.gov) for recommended vaccinations specific to Belize.

- Students will be encouraged not to use their phones during the week except to take pictures. Wifi will not be available. ***Your student may incur international roaming fees if they turn on their phones while in Belize.***
