What does PBIS look like at Manning Oaks?

These expectations will be posted and taught throughout our building. We believe helping students practice good behavior, enables us to build a school community where ALL students CAN succeed and grow both academically and socially. We will use the matrix included with this letter to help teach and clarify these expectations. Students who are caught exhibiting desired behaviors outlined in the behavior matrix of expectations will be rewarded with Dojo points!

How can you be a partner in this effort?

We want you to be a partner in helping us make our school an even more positive place for our children to learn. To ensure that you as parents and your child/children as students are aware of the school expectations; we ask that you review the matrix (on the back) in its entirety with your child/children. Additional ways to be involved are: using the expectations in your home, reminding your child/children of expectations each day, make sure your child arrives on time to school, and inquiring about their day each afternoon.
