**Principal's Update**

- Late Start Day
  - September 20th – All homeroom, EIP, ESOL, and IRR teachers participated in PLC planning or professional development.
  - October 25th - We will have to split grade levels this time as other schools are doing. We are unable to have all teachers participate at the same time. Teachers still will engage in PLC work or professional learning.
- Boosterthon Annual Fundraiser
  - We raised approximately \$16,000. Money will be used for books, instructional resources, and devices.
- I-Ready Challenge
  - We are asking students to participate in an I Ready Challenge where they complete 45 minutes of math and 45 minutes of reading I Ready lessons. There will be grade level, class, and student prizes given.
