4:30pm	Action Item: Spending Charter System Dollars Mr. Hetherington and Ms. Rosenthal discussed the charter system dollars available to spend. There was roughly around \$5,270.00 remaining in the fund of what we had already spent. Three ideas were presented from the staff. <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Replace the mat outside the front of the building. This would be a branded and logo printed mat to promote a welcoming and inviting environment as students enter the school building. This would cost around \$2,190.00.2) Ms. Rosenthal asked teachers about wish lists for next year. There was a wish for more books for the lower levels in KK-2nd. This would cost around \$985.00.3) Multiple grade levels also requested headphones for the students since they get broken or destroyed often. This would cost around \$1,600.00. Mr. Snow asked if money could be rolled over into next year. The money in the charter system dollars fund must be spent this year. Additionally, money must be spent on non-personnel items.
