Dr. Morrissey opened the floor for discussion in regard to the Safety and Security funds (\$21,500) earmarked for CMS that must be spent by end of fall semester. Ideas included defibrillators, first aid kits for teacher emergency bags, planters/barriers to bar car traffic from the plaza, signage for carpool & other, golf/utility cart for use by school police officer, CSA and/or staff to patrol campus or transport any injured students etc. Costs will be researched for decision making next mtg.

Mr. Botelho led discussion of planning ideas for Fall Community Tour. Date will be Thursday, Dec. 1st. Sub-committee of Communication and Community Relations members and any other SGC members that are interested will collaborate before the next SGC meeting using a shared document that Ms. Pritchard volunteered to create. Topics to cover will include invitation list, tour plan, school staff to incorporate for visits, musical performances, to-do lists, etc.
